When we receive this information, we will begin processing the documents for the Special Service Area. State Law allows for a sixty (60) day period after the Public Hearing for owners to file objections to the establishment of the Special Service Area so the process to complete the establishment of the SSA can take 90 to 120 days depending on the Council cycles.

State Law also requires that Notice of the Public Hearing to Establish the Special Service Area be published once at least fifteen (15) days prior to the Public Hearing. We will publish this notice but you will be required to reimburse the City for this cost prior to finalizing the Special Service Area.

Please also be advised that the tax rate the City will use in the Special Service Area documents should the Special Service Area ever be activated is \$1.10 per hundred dollars of assessed valuation. This is a standardized amount that the City uses in all Special Service Areas and is not subject to negotiation.

Further documents that the City will require before processing are:

- 1. Legal Description of the Project (emailed in a word document) to lschindel@aurora-il.org
- 2. Accurate site map on 8 ½" x 11.00" paper showing project site, interior streets and major arterial streets and the project relationship to the City of Aurora. (The City will prepare this on your behalf)
