Failure to so elect within said time shall constitute authorization to the City to complete the improvements or maintenance at Surety's expense. The maximum liability of the Surety shall be limited to the total amount of this bond for completion of improvements. Upon final acceptance by City Council action, developer shall secure a one-year maintenance bond to the City Council guaranteeing against deficiencies in workmanship and materials. Such bond shall be drawn in an amount equal to twenty (20) percent of the total cost for improvements and be written for a period of one (1) year after acceptance of the improvements as required by the City's Subdivision ordinance (Sec. 43-103(c)(7)).
