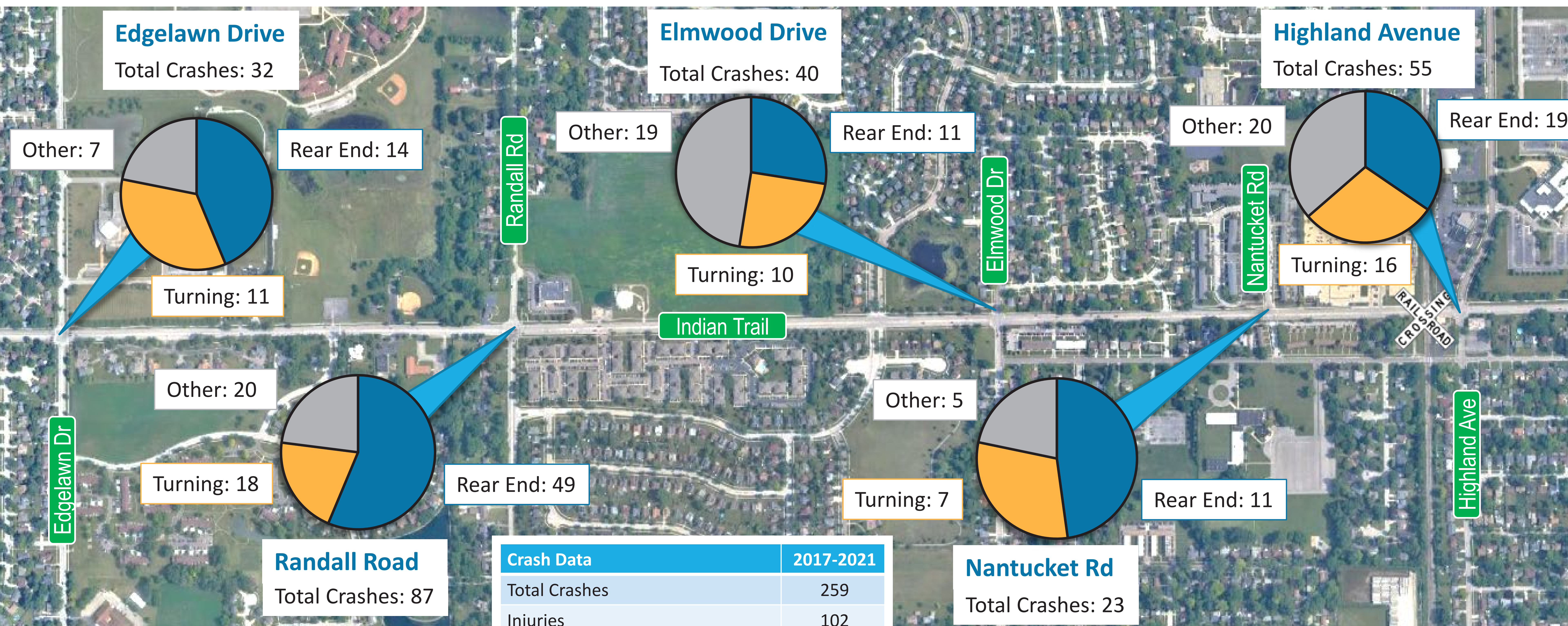

# Traffic Signal Flashing Yellow Arrow

FROM THIS



TO THIS



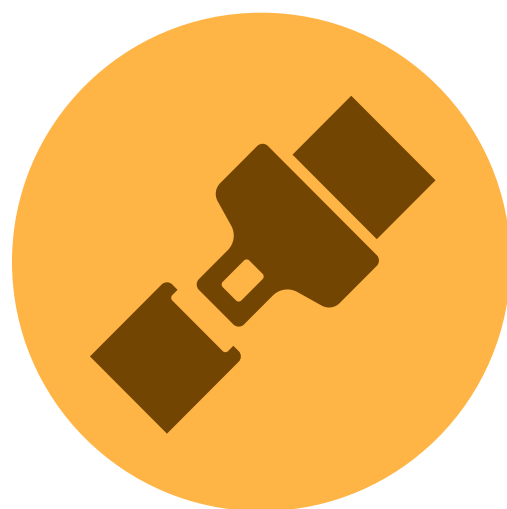
**Steady Red Arrow**  
*Drivers turning left must stop and wait (except where permitted by law).*

**Steady Yellow Arrow**  
*Stop, if you can do so safely.*

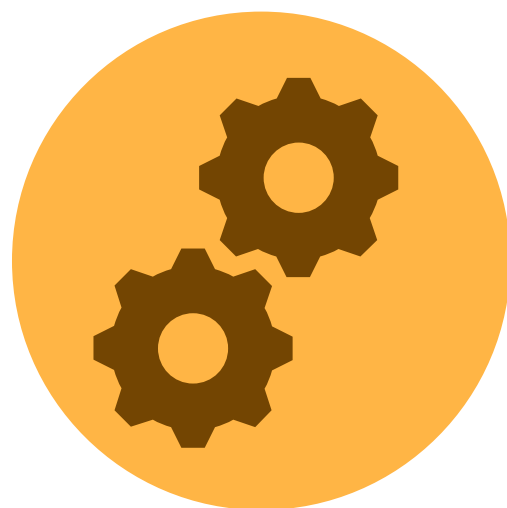
**Flashing Yellow Arrow**  
*Proceed with left turn after yielding to oncoming traffic and pedestrians.*

**Steady Green Arrow**  
*Proceed with left turn.*

## BENEFITS



**Safer** – A national study demonstrated drivers had fewer crashes with flashing yellow left turn arrow than with traditional signals.



**More Flexibility** – Signal operations can be adjusted based on time of day and traffic volumes to improve safety and/or reduce delay.
